Why RCSI?

Located in the heart of the capital city alongside historical Georgian buildings, RCSI has played a key role in medical education and training in Ireland for over 200 years.

Globally accredited

RCSI has a worldwide reputation for training excellent doctors with superior clinical and communication skills. It was the first Irish Medical School (2006) to be approved and accredited by the Irish Medical Council to deliver a four year medical programme for graduates - the 'Graduate Entry Programme' (GEP), and is the most sought after graduate entry programme in Ireland. Graduates are conferred with the Licentiates of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland and the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland (LRCSI and LRCPI), as well as the internationally recognised medical degrees of the National University of Ireland (MB, BCh, BAO).

International diversity

More than 60 countries are represented within RCSI's international student body. North America accounts for 24% of our student population. This attests to our ability to provide a medical education which is transferable and desirable as evidenced by our match rate success.

Academic leadership

RCSI has strong academic and clinical teams who strive for excellence in education and research with a shared mission of 'developing healthcare leaders who make a difference worldwide.' Our main teaching hospital (Beaumont Hospital) is the National Centre for Neurosurgery, Renal Transplantation, Cochlear Transplantation and Alpha 1 Antitrypsin deficiency.

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


Career Development and RCSI Mentor Network




Residency

Canada Residency – Class of 2013





The Dean's office is receptive to the needs and requests of students aiming for a North American residency and has garnered a very strong, easily accessible alumni network for advice to current students. There are vast opportunities for extra-curricular activities in sport, culture, research, local aide, and elective excursions in the developing world. In addition to all of this, I can retrospectively say that

the emphasis of clinical-based learning and physical diagnosis is unparalleled and has vastly helped me in mastering "the art" of medicine. And most importantly, Paris, Barcelona, Berlin, Rome, Amsterdam, London, and the snow-capped Alps are all within a two-hour flight from Dublin!"
